

Notes on Choosing Courses at the Universidad de Burgos (UBU)

primarily for Spanish majors

Burgos courses

Some Spanish courses only last 20h, so they would not carry 4 credits when transferring back.

Courses at UBU that have 6 ECTS are eligible to count as full (4 credit) courses at W&J.

Our Spanish department always recommends an advanced language class, even if it would transfer back as either 4 credits for graduation only (if 300 elective has been done previously) or as the 300-level elective. Note from Dr. Alpañés: courses marked "English Friendly"- as students can get handouts and exams in English, do not count for the Spanish major.
