STUDENT GOVERNMENT PRINCIPLES OF OPERATION OF STUDENT-FACULTY COMMITTEES

- A. Student representatives on faculty committees must be full-time students who have completed at least eight courses at W&J, must not be on academic or social probation, and must meet any additional eligibility requirements established by the student body.
- B. Student representatives on faculty committees shall be certified to the Committee on Committees by the President of Student Government, who shall also certify that the representatives meet all requirements of eligibility and that they have been chosen in conformity with democratic process.
- C. Student representatives shall serve for one-year term, with possibility of renewal. If a student becomes ineligible to serve because of academic or social probation, the Committee on Committees shall declare the seat vacant and request the President of Student Government to initiate the action necessary to fill the vacancy.
- D. If a committee member is repeatedly absent from meetings of a committee(s), the chairperson of the committee shall notify the Committee on Committees and request an investigation and recommendation for action.
- E. The Committee on Committees may vary the number of people on a given committee if such action is desirable. In addition, the President may appoint additional members to any committee, including elected committees.
