The Spring 2015 contest was open to students who were abroad on W&J-affiliated travel (e.g., semester abroad or travel intersession course) during the fall 2014 semester, spring 2014 semester, intersession 2015 or summer 2014 Magellan Project.

This fall, the Office of Study Abroad received over 100 photos, which were submitted for judging in the various categories: Architecture, Culture, Landscape, Miscellaneous and W&J Pride. A select committee of faculty, staff and students trimmed the submissions to determine the finalists.
