Eligible W&J participants should submit their photos for consideration in any of the following five categories:

- Architecture
 - Photos of structures and buildings
- Culture & Real Life
 - Any photo that captures the unique essence of the local flavor, cultural aspects of the location, or photos of groups of people or individuals
- Landscape/Nature
 - Photos of urban, country or natural landscapes, including animals
- Miscellaneous
 - Any photo that doesn't fit specifically in any of the above categories
- W&J Pride
 - Any photos of you and your W&J gear/logo
